College credit hours completed prior to high school graduation, including Early College Program courses, do not affect scholarship eligibility. Ohio reciprocity counties include: Adams, Athens, Brown, Gallia, Jackson, Lawrence, Meigs, Pike, Scioto and Vinton.

Awards based on academic criteria. Final GPA and official ACT scores affect awards. Awards, with the exception of Alumni and Valedictorian, may not be combined. Total financial aid can not exceed cost of attendance. Subsequent changes do not apply to the terms and conditions of an award.
